

Nomination Requirements

Residency Requirements

1.1.1 Nominees for induction to the Hall of Fame must have resided, worked or competed in the Greater Illiana Area (Indiana – Seeger, Covington, Fountain Central, Attica, North Vermillion, South Vermillion, Parke Heritage, Riverton Parke, Turkey Run, Rockville, Williamsport, Pine Village, Veedersburg, Richland Township, Wallace, Kingman, Clinton, Montezuma, Perrysville, Newport, Cayuga and Dana. Illinois – Danville Area Community College, Chrisman, Georgetown Ridge Farm, Salt Fork, Westville, Oakwood, Danville, Schlarman/Danville, Bismarck/Henning/Rossville/Alvin, Armstrong/Potomac, Hoopeston/Rankin/East Lynn, Wellington, Milford, Sidell, Fairmount, Jamaica, Shilo, Indianola and Scotland), for at least two full seasons in their sport. Teams nominated for induction to the Hall of Fame must be based in the Greater Illiana Area, as defined above.

Additional Requirements

1.2.1 Athlete nominees for induction to the Hall of Fame are eligible for nomination 10 years after high school graduation. Individual athlete nominees must be a state **or** national champion, **or** they are in a state or national hall of fame, **or** they are former professional athletes. A waiver of the requirement clause may be granted, by unanimous consent of the selection committee.

1.2.2 Coaching nominees for induction to the Hall of Fame must be in a state or national hall of fame. A waiver of the requirement clause may be granted, by unanimous consent of the selection committee.

1.2.3 Team nominees are eligible for nomination 10 years after their team accomplishments. Team nominees must be state or national champions. A waiver of the requirement clause may be granted, by unanimous consent of the selection committee.

1.2.4 The “Legends” nominees are anyone not included in the team, coach or individual athlete categories (this category includes athletic trainers, support staff, media, administrators, officials, volunteers, etc.). A waiver of the requirement clause may be granted, by the unanimous consent of the selection committee.
